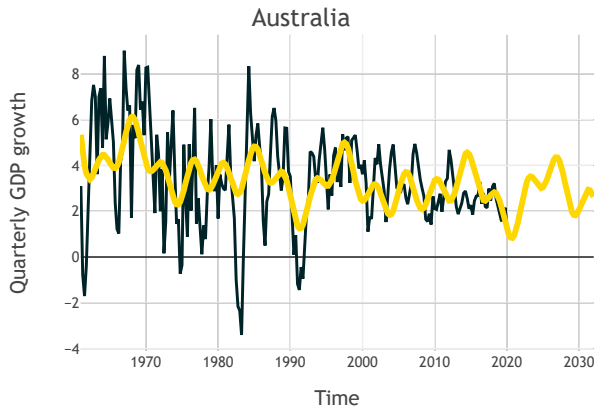


Figure 1: harmonic regression fit for Australia.

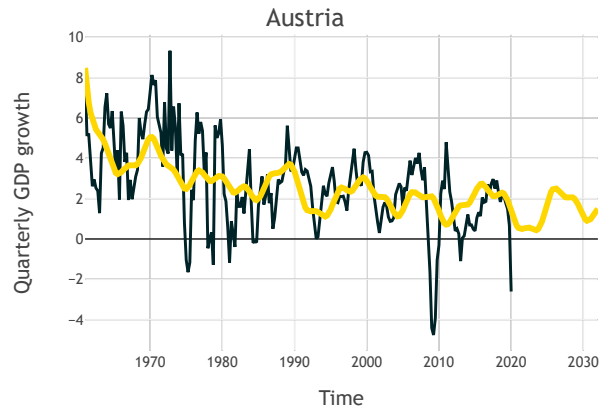


Figure 2: harmonic regression fit for Austria.

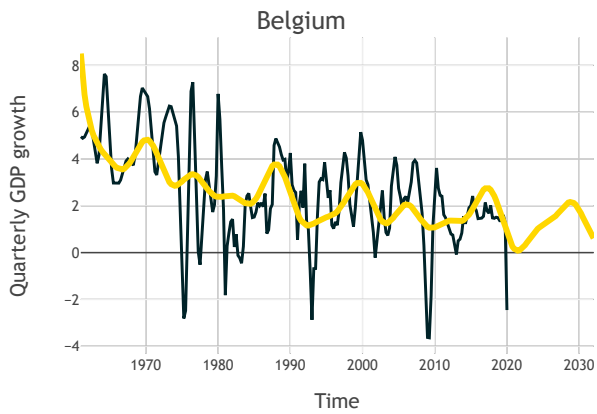


Figure 3: harmonic regression fit for Belgium.

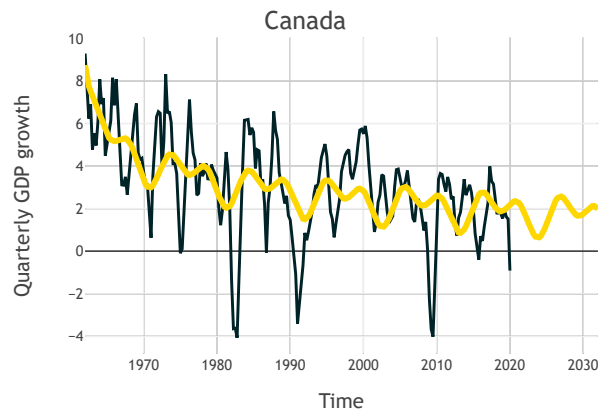


Figure 4: harmonic regression fit for Canada.

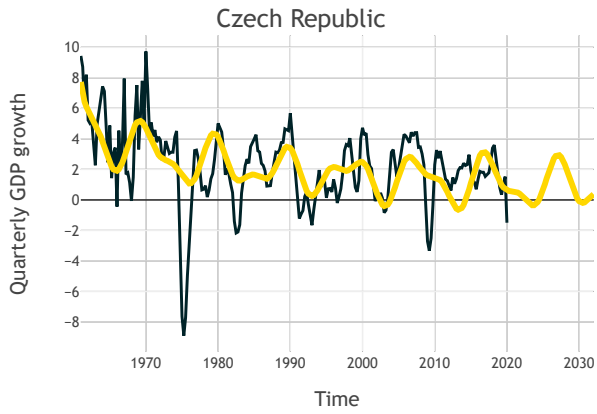


Figure 5: harmonic regression fit for Czech Republic.

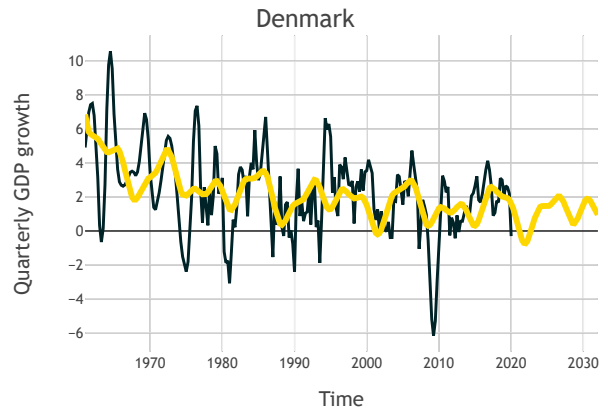


Figure 6: harmonic regression fit for Denmark.

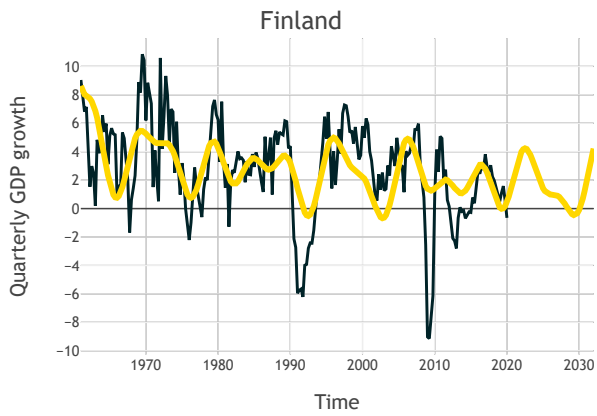


Figure 7: harmonic regression fit for Finland.

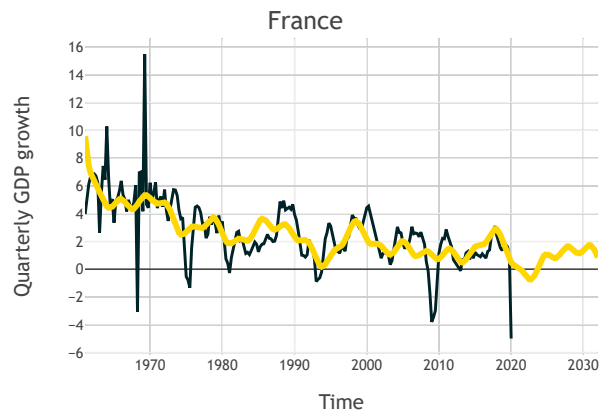


Figure 8: harmonic regression fit for France.

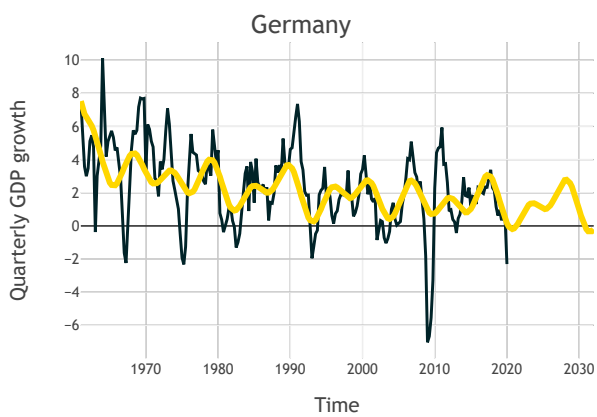


Figure 9: harmonic regression fit for Germany.

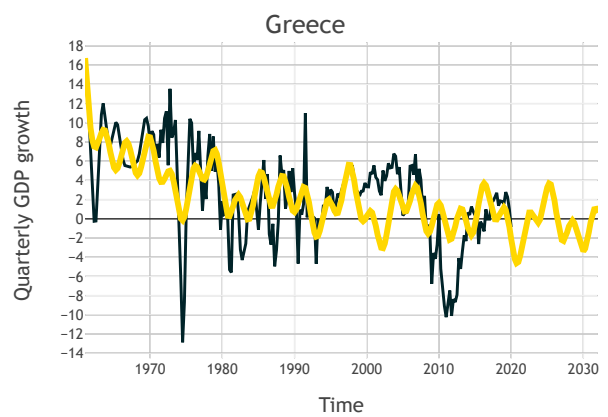


Figure 10: harmonic regression fit for Greece.

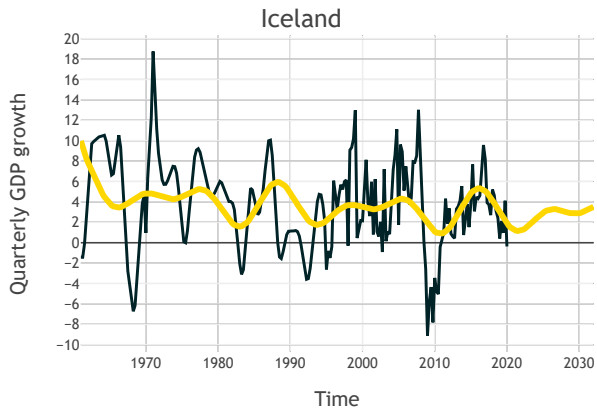


Figure 11: harmonic regression fit for Iceland.

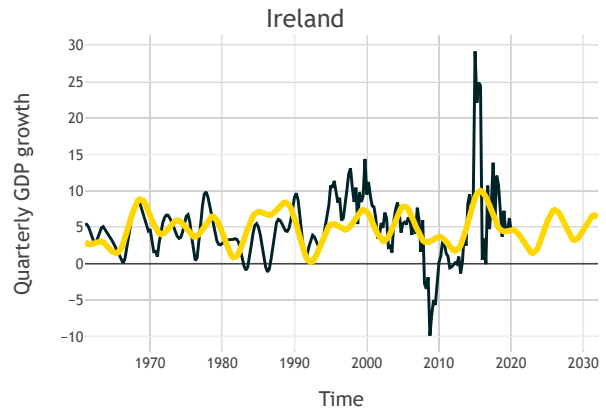


Figure 12: harmonic regression fit for Ireland.

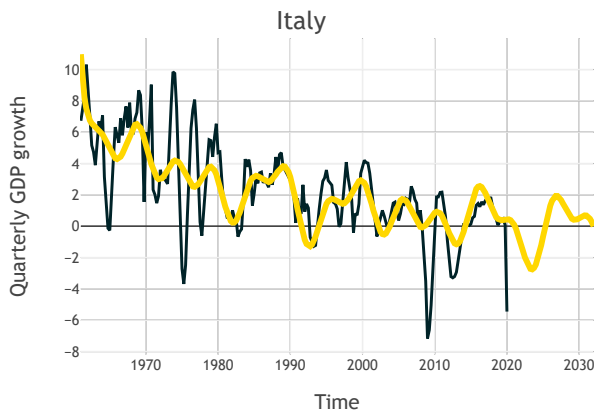


Figure 13: harmonic regression fit for Italy.

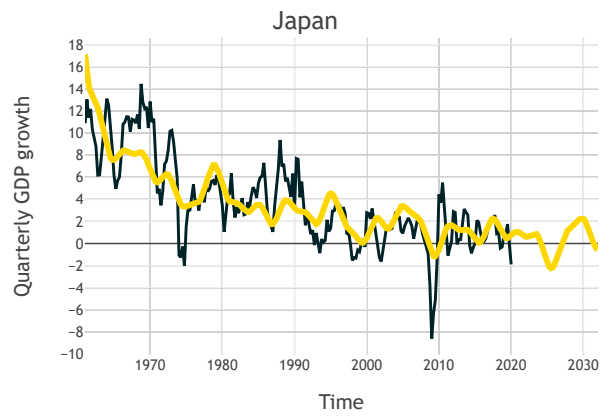


Figure 14: harmonic regression fit for Japan.

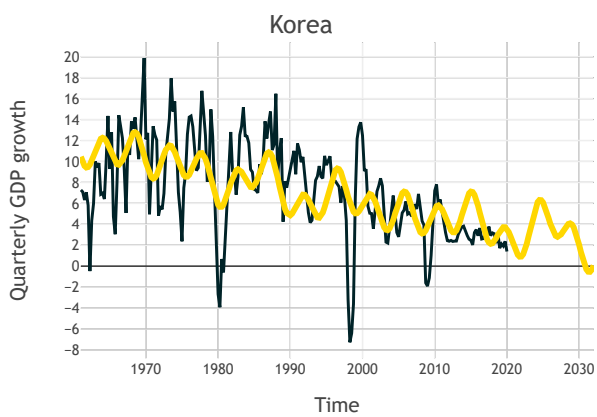


Figure 15: harmonic regression fit for Korea.

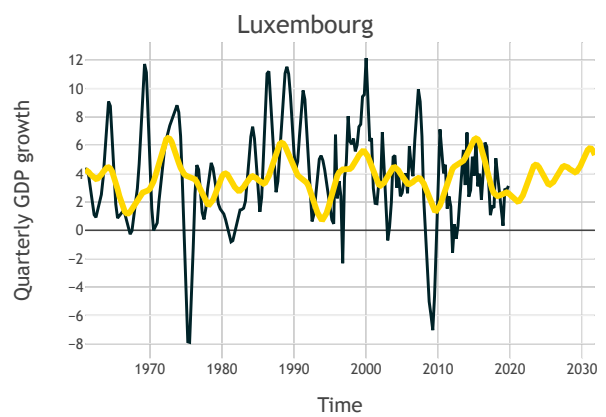


Figure 16: harmonic regression fit for Luxembourg.

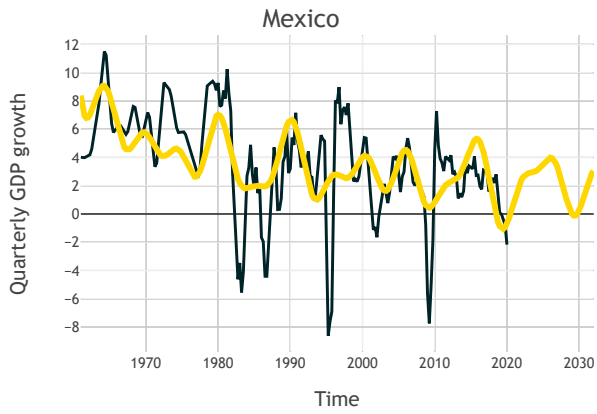


Figure 17: harmonic regression fit for Mexico.

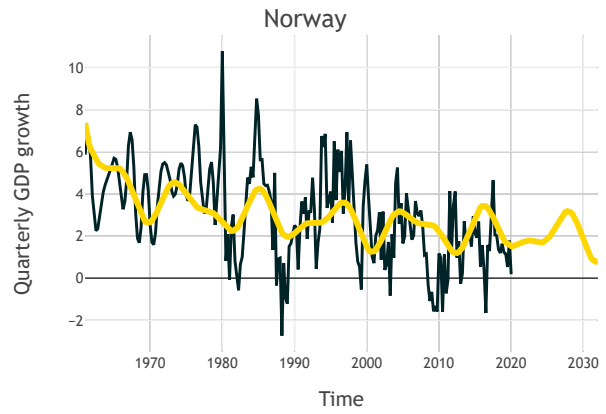


Figure 18: harmonic regression fit for Norway.

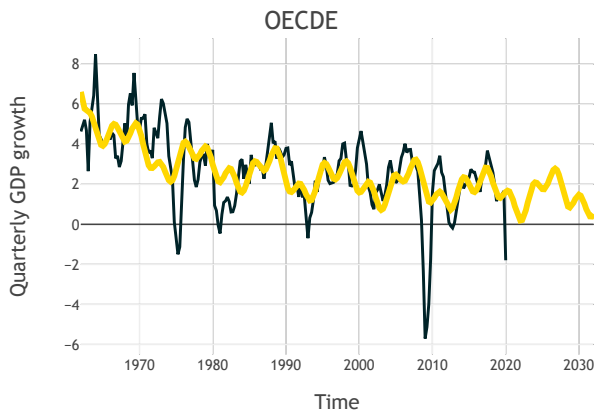


Figure 19: harmonic regression fit for the European OECD countries.

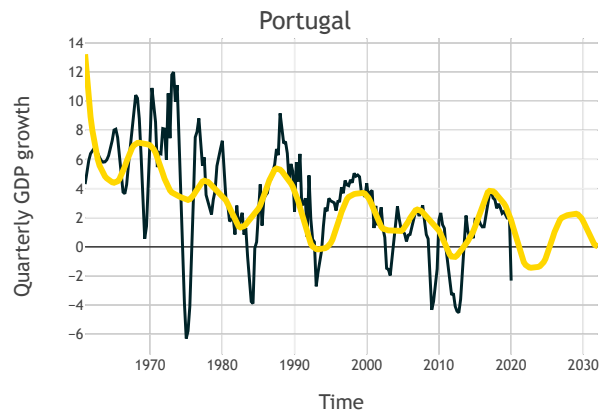


Figure 20: harmonic regression fit for Portugal.

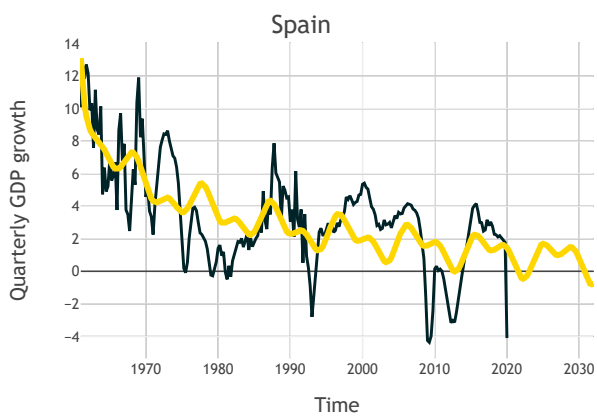


Figure 21: harmonic regression fit for Spain.

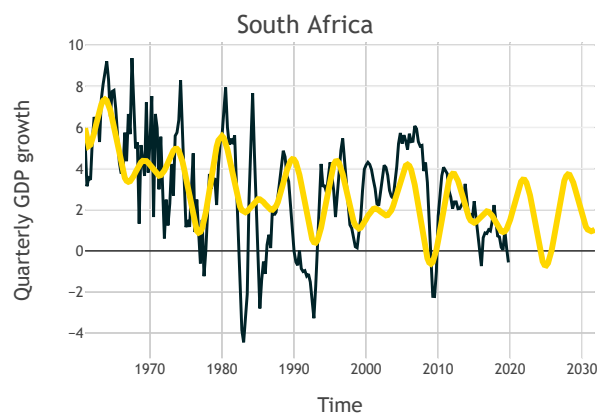


Figure 22: harmonic regression fit for South Africa.

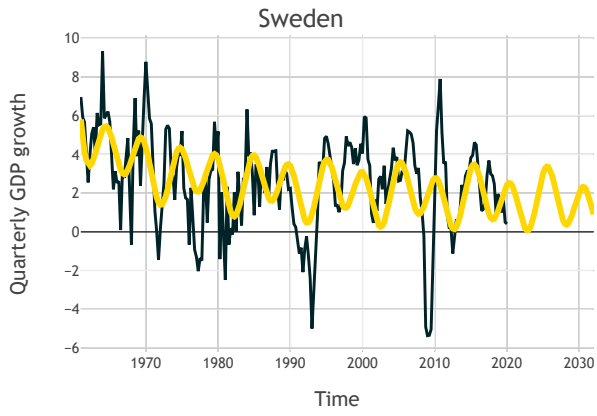


Figure 23: harmonic regression fit for Sweden.

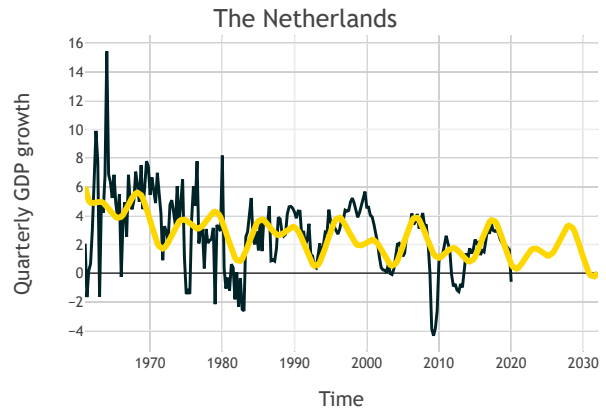


Figure 24: harmonic regression fit for The Netherlands.

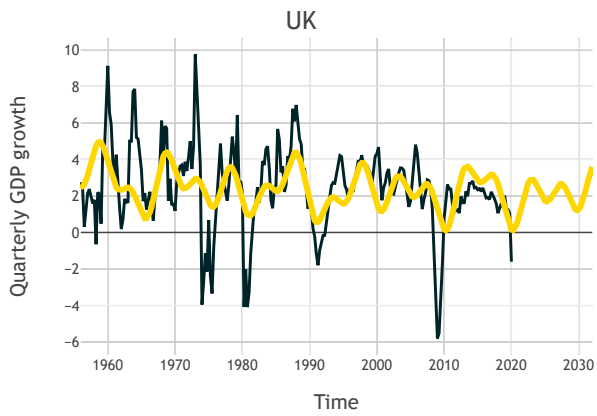


Figure 25: harmonic regression fit for UK.

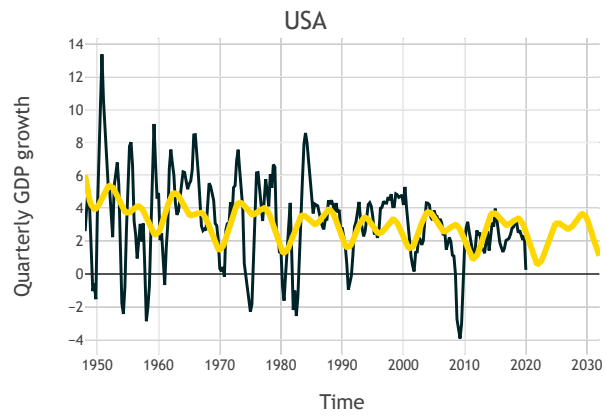


Figure 26: harmonic regression fit for USA.
